Food sold or served in schools will be prepared and handled in a safe manner and will take into account the nutritional needs of children and youths.

PREAMBLE

Direction must be provided to schools on the provision of food services to students.

FOOD SERVICE**REGULATIONS:**

1. The principal, in consultation with students, staff and parents, is responsible for ensuring that among the food items sold or served are choices that are high in nutritional value. Nutritional choices must also be available where vending machines or concessions have been installed.
2. Each school shall have a staff member or other person with a Foodsafe certificate present to ensure that Foodsafe regulations are met with respect to the food served and the procedures used.
3. Schools may enter into or renew existing exclusive contracts with food or beverage suppliers only after obtaining input from the student council or other representative student group, the school parent advisory council and the manager of purchasing, and after receiving approval from the assistant superintendent.
