

## Spread the Net News Release:

### Beaverly Elementary School among winners of the tenth annual Spread the Net Student Challenge to prevent malaria Beaverly Elementary School honoured as top fundraising elementary school

Prince George, BC, March 8, 2017 – Beaverly Elementary School is pleased to be honoured by Rick Mercer and Plan International Canada as the top fundraising elementary school in the tenth annual *Spread the Net* Student Challenge, a friendly nationwide competition between schools that raises funds for malaria-preventing bed nets in Africa. The school raised a total of \$26,900.

Mercer – television personality, co-founder of *Spread the Net*, and champion of the Student Challenge – announced the results on the March 7 episode of the Rick Mercer Report. Mercer will visit each of the winning schools and feature them on the March 28 season finale of his show in celebration of their outstanding fundraising efforts and school spirit.

The other winners of this year's *Spread the Net* Student Challenge are:

- Father Mercredi High School, Fort McMurray, AB – raised \$10,168 (Top secondary school)
- Langara College, Vancouver, BC – raised \$14,625 (Top post-secondary school)
- R.A. Riddell Elementary School, Hamilton ON – raised \$16,355 (Wild card school)

As part of Plan International Canada's *Spread the Net* Student Challenge this year, over 50 schools raised close to \$150,000 for live-saving bed nets that will prevent malaria-infected mosquitoes from biting children and their families at night. Global efforts to end the malaria epidemic are making significant progress, but over 400,000 people still die of malaria each year, the vast majority of them under the age of five. One child under the age of five dies of malaria every two minutes.

"Year after year, I'm amazed by the young Canadians who participate in the *Spread the Net* Student Challenge and find new and creative ways to raise funds and awareness for the global fight against malaria," says Mercer. "Schools have gone all out for the tenth year of *Spread the Net*, and the enthusiasm from students across the country is remarkable. I look forward to meeting the winning schools and celebrating their impressive efforts in the season finale of the Rick Mercer Report." Since 2007, more than 800 elementary, secondary and post-secondary schools across Canada have participated in the Student Challenge, raising over \$1.6 million for the fight against malaria.

### About Spread the Net

*Spread the Net* is a Plan International Canada initiative designed to educate and inspire Canadians to help end preventable malaria deaths by raising funds and awareness to support the purchase and distribution of bed nets, along with training on their use, to children and their families in Africa. *Spread the Net* was founded in 2006 by Belinda Stronach, P.C., and Rick Mercer, becoming an initiative of Plan International Canada in July 2013. ## Science Exhibition:



The 41st Central Interior Science Exhibition takes place on **Saturday April 1** at UNBC. It is an all day event where students in grades 4 to 12 display science fair projects that they have completed. The registration fee is \$20 per person. No more than two people can be partners, but students can also carry out the experiment or study on their own. Students who compete will be eligible to receive medals, trophies, merchandise prizes and cash awards, including scholarships for students in grades 11 and 12. Five deserving students from grades 7 to 12 will be chosen to attend the National Science Fair in Regina SK in May, 2017. Hands on science activities will take place throughout the morning and afternoon. The public is invited to come and have a look from 2 to 4:30 p.m. and from 6:00 to 6:45 p.m. The awards ceremony takes place from 7 to 8:30 p.m. in the Canfor Theatre at UNBC.
