

# ONLINE DELAY NOTIFICATIONS


Hello,

We are happy to announce our new delay notification services for our School Bus Runs.

At Diversified Transportation, we strive for safe and punctual service. In the event that a route is delayed 10+ minutes, our Drivers are required to contact our dispatch centre and delays will be posted.

To sign up for **email notifications**:

1. Please log in to [www.diversifiedbusbc.com](http://www.diversifiedbusbc.com)
2. Click on "Services"
3. Select "Student Transportation"
4. Click on "Delay Notifications"
5. Type your email
6. Confirm your email
7. Enter carrier profile. It is "dtlbc".
8. Click on "confirm".
9. Click "next"
10. Select the school that belongs to the route you wish to select.
11. Select the route you wish to receive notifications.
12. Click on "add"
13. Repeat steps 10-12 for any routes you need.
