PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Thanks to everyone for our Drive-by spring break send off
 - Very successful
 - Made it onto CKPG news
 - Technology breakdown occurred

- School org
 - Meetings in progress
 - 214 children enrolled
 - 18 kindergarten registered for the fall
 - 5 children on transition
 - Not changing learning groups
 - EA/support team changes expected
 - Possibility of principal movement
 - Laurie has requested to stay at Edgewood Elementary
- Health & Safety
 - Mask mandate for grades 4 – 7s
 - Wearing masks in class, around the school, and in line ups (except when eating)
 - Still doing daily health checks
- Positive infrastructure changes
 - Storage area revamp
 - All new windows
 - New front-entry carpet
 - Voice amplification system for gym
 - Staffroom re-design

TREASURER'S REPORT

- General account
 - ~\$23K+
 - Hunniford cheque will bring account down to ~\$18K
 - Fundraising goals set for the year
 - ~\$5K
 - Dial family funded Grade 7 hoodies
 - **ACTION:** Laurie Bryce Acknowledge/thank the Dial family in the school newsletter for funding the Grade 7 hoodies
- Gaming account
 - ~\$11K+
 - Hoping to receive and spend ~\$4K
 - Funds must be used within three years
- New requirements for gaming allow for purchase of:
 - Playground equipment
 - Extra-curricular sports
 - Cultural events
- Gaming fund usage discussion
 - Playground equipment was preferred choice to spend funds on
 - Suggestion to use skiing funds for teacher-approved event
 - ~\$7K available to use; can also look at using ~\$10K in general account funds
 - Suggested to use district provider for school equipment
 - Laurie to confirm list of playground equipment suppliers
 - Suggestion to have school vote on options
 - **ACTION:** Sarah Foot will contact suppliers for playground pricing
 - Option to have primary/intermediate playground
 - Some of our structures will be removed
 - Sarah motioned to utilize ~\$7K in gaming funds and ~\$10K in general account funds to purchase playground equipment, with children choosing components; seconded by Lacey
 - All in favour
