PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 199 children enrolled at this time
 - o 7 students at home to school
 - o 3 students dual enrolled
- 2 new EAs have joined the staff
- Found lower numbers of behaviour referrals last month
 - o Disrespect and non-compliance have been an issue
- Toy issues
 - o Too many toys are coming to school
 - Fidgets
 - Distracting and disruptive
 - o Comfort toys are fine as long as they stay in back packs, for the most part
 - o Pokémon cards are fine to bring, but no trading allowed
- Student Learning support model
 - o LA
 - o ELI
 - o ST (Support Teacher) previously RT
 - o Direct (focussed) and non-direct consultation service
- Health & Wellness
 - o Concern around staff wellness /emotional well being
 - Lots of sickness this year
 - No COVID exposure notices so far
 - Cleaning protocols have been reduced
 - No daytime custodians
 - **ACTION:** Andi Duperron Touch base with DPAC re: reduced COVID cleaning protocols this school year
 - o Only 20 subs available for SD57
