## Communicating Student Learning

At the end of June students will receive a summative report of their learning along with a self assessment of one of the core competencies (Communication, Thinking, Personal/Social).

### Importance of self-assessment

Students come to the classroom with experience and knowledge related to the Core Competencies. Self-assessment will allow them to develop the ability to describe themselves as unique individuals in relation to the Core Competencies. They will set goals and gain greater ownership of their learning when they have the opportunity to self-assess and describe who they are as learners, document their progress, and share their accomplishments in an ongoing and holistic manner.

Research on assessment emphasizes the importance of students developing reflective language and metacognition (ie. The ability to think about thinking) in order to engage in effective self-assessment. It is important that over time students:

- \* Gain the ability to assess their own strengths
- \* Create realistic and achievable goals
- \* Construct a clear plan to reach their goals
- \* Provide examples and evidence of their learning
- \* Revisit previous documentations of self-assessments, where applicable, to monitor their growth
