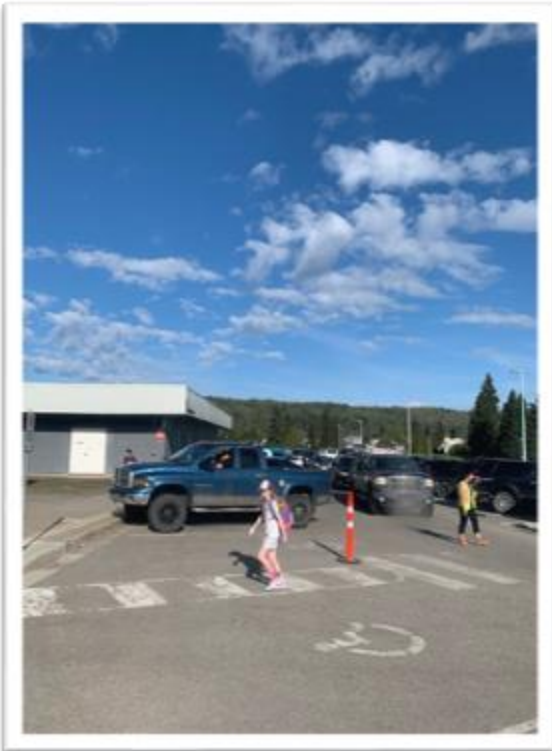
Why do we need your help?

A significant number of SD57 students are driven to school daily. Many of our parking lots and school zones are congested, particularly at peak times. We want to ensure these spaces are safe for students, families, and staff alike.



What we know:

- Most crashes involving pedestrians occur between 3pm and 6pm within the fall and winter months (source: ICBC)
- One in five people killed in car crashes are pedestrians (source: ICBC)
- Congested parking lots make it difficult to see children; please slow down and be aware of your surroundings



Parking Lot & School Zone Reminders

We ask that you please:

- Observe all posted speed limits and traffic signs
- Yield to pedestrians and crossing guards
- Enter and exit using designated areas
- Refrain from passing
- Refrain from parking in bus lanes
- Refrain from completing “u-turns”
- Use turn signals
- Refrain from accessing handicapped spots unless you have a permit
- Refrain from driving in reverse aside from backing up
- Refrain from idling
