Lauren Irving - Family Nurse Practitioner (CINH)

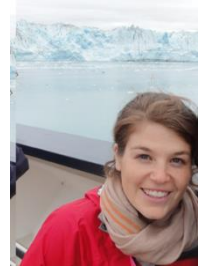
