The meals program, both breakfast and lunch, have been jazzed up. Check it out!!!

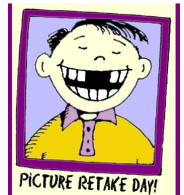

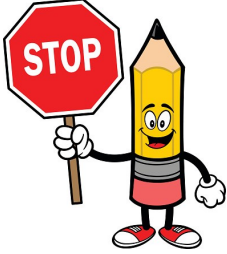
Student Verification Forms
