Over the course of a year, the temperature typically varies from 23°C to -13°C. The successful candidate will be a collaborative educator who possess exemplary interpersonal skills, a record of improving measurable student success, and a strong work ethic. Cultural competency in the area of Aboriginal Education is required as is the ability to lead inclusivity throughout the school community.
