

# 2020-21 SD57 Options for School

## In Class Instruction

- Students attend their home school in their classrooms as part of a Learning Group.
- Students will receive regular instruction of curriculum by their classroom teacher.
- Students with immunocompromised conditions or live with a family member with immunocompromised condition should work with their school to develop a plan.

Please contact your school Principal to register or regarding options below.

## Transition to In Class Instruction

- Students will be provided an opportunity for a gradual entry back to school— please work with your school on an education plan during this transition time.

### ELEMENTARY

- With some support from the school students will enter school by:
  - September 30th
  - October 30th
  - November 30th
  - January 5th

### SECONDARY

- Schools will support at home learning as students transition back to in class instruction.

## Distributed (Distance) Learning (DL)

- Students apply to be enrolled in Central Interior Distance Education School (CIDES).
- Upon approved registration, students will withdraw from their home school and become a CIDES student— If students want to attend their home catchment school again, they must register with the school at the designated times in the year.
- Grades 10-12 students may take some classes at their home school and some classes at CIDES upon approval from both the home school and CIDES

## Home Schooling

- Students will withdraw from their home school and SD57
- Parents are responsible for the entire educational program at home (instruction, curriculum and assessment)
- Homeschoolers are not eligible to receive a British Columbia Dogwood Graduation Certificate.
