### School District No. 57 Extra-Curricular Event Protocols

#### Rationale:

- In person viewing of events in School District No. 57 is a privilege at this time. It is expected that all protocols listed below are followed in order to continue allowing spectators at school events.
- It is intended that spectators watch their child's game and leave the school immediately. Spectators are not to stay in school after their child's game, and are expected to arrive in the gym just before the game. We need to avoid congestion at all times.

#### Spectator Agreement in SD57 Schools:

- All spectators, volunteers, organizers, coaches, officials, **age 22 and older are vaccinated if the event takes place ON SCHOOL PROPERTY**
- All spectators, volunteers, organizers, coaches, officials, **age 12 and older are vaccinated if the event takes place OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY**
- Masks must be worn at all times in the school and in the gymnasium
  - School Mask exemptions do not apply for extracurricular events
- Sanitize hands upon entering the building
- All spectators must sign the visitor sign in
- Maximum 50% capacity in the gymnasium
- Maintain physical distancing wherever possible
- No food or drink in the school
- **There is a COVID Safety plan available upon request**

#### Safety/Support for Spectator Agreement:

- Athletic Director/Tournament Supervisor on site at tournaments
  - staff member / AD can contact school Principal/Vice Principal if any issues/concerns arise for support
- Custodial and Security staff on-site
- Health and Safety is everyone's responsibility to ensure for safe environment.

#### Spectator agreement:

- Posted in entrances, gym entrances, SD No. 57 website, and social media
- distributed to all athletic teams attending tournaments
