



## SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 57 (PRINCE GEORGE)

### **Important Notes for Potential Nominees and Candidates:**

1. The candidate must sign Document No. CS2, (page 3 of 3) of the *Candidate Nomination Package – School Trustee* in front of the Chief Election Officer (or Deputy), or Commissioner for Taking Affidavits.
2. Please refer to the City of Prince George website [www.princegeorge.ca](http://www.princegeorge.ca) for important information regarding City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202 and “Political Signs on City Owned Property”. Please refer to the District of Mackenzie, Village of Valemount, and Village of McBride for information regarding sign regulations.
3. For information about candidate and elector organization campaign financing refer to the *Guide to Local Elections Campaign Financing in B.C.* and *Third Party Advertising Sponsor Guide to Local Elections in B.C.* available from Elections BC. Their website is [www.elections.bc.ca](http://www.elections.bc.ca) and their toll free number is 1.800.661.8683.
4. Disclosure statements on election campaign financing must be filed with Elections BC and not the Chief Election Officer by January 13, 2023. This requirement applies regardless of whether the candidate won or lost the election, was acclaimed to office, withdrew from the election, received no campaign contributions, or incurred no election expenses.

A late fee will be charged to a deadline of February 13, 2023. Failure to file this disclosure report will result in the person being disqualified from running in the next local government election.

The requirement for disclosure of election campaign financing is a separate matter from the requirement for elected officials to file personal financial disclosure statements on an annual basis.
