

We are pleased to provide you with the updated UNBC Dual Credit nomination package for the 2021/22 academic year!

Attached, you will find the following:

- 1. Dual Credit Nomination Package**
 - a. Completed by counsellor, student, and parent; returned to counsellor to include in the student's package.
- 2. Dual Credit Application Form**
 - a. Completed by student; returned to counsellor include in the student's package.
- 3. Dual Credit Sponsorship Form**
 - a. Completed by school Principal; returned to counsellor to include in the student's package.
- 4. Approved Dual Credit Course List for Fall 2021**
 - a. Winter 2022 schedule to be released later this summer, and May 2022 schedule is released Spring 2022.

What is Dual Credit?

- Dual Credit is a program that allows students who are nominated by a school representative and parent/guardian to take up to three UNBC courses in their grade 12 years (one course per semester that overlaps their senior year).
- The Dual Credit UNBC courses they complete earn them elective credits toward high school graduation as well as first-year university credit toward a degree.
- Tuition is funded by the BC Ministry of Education and the student fees are waived by UNBC. There is no application fee. Students must pay for their textbooks and any additional course costs.
- Students can apply for Dual Credit as early as the final semester of their grade 11 year to take a course (up to 4 credits per semester) in each of the following:
 - o Fall 2021 (Sept – Dec)
 - o Winter 2022 (Jan – Apr)
 - o May-June 2022

What is new with the process this year?

- To aid with the completeness of packages and simplicity in return, we ask that counsellors collect all required forms on behalf of the student and submit completed nomination/application/sponsorship form packages to admissions@unbc.ca all at once (by student as

they come in, waiting for all students before submitting is not necessary.)

- Due to COVID-19, UNBC has not finalized its Fall 2021 or Winter 2022 course schedules. We have been able to produce a draft Approved Course List for Fall 2021 to accompany this package, but the final schedule will be confirmed sometime in June. What is displayed in the attached document could change. The Winter 2022 approved course list will be sent to schools and students later on this summer.
