Statement question: describe how you demonstrated one or more of the Core Competencies (or sub-competencies) in the B.C. Curriculum in your most relevant volunteer or work experiences.

Your statement must address the following:

- ✓ What led you to your most relevant community service, volunteer activity, and/or leadership role?
- ✓ What challenges or obstacles (if any) did you encounter, and how did you overcome them?
- ✓ What have you learned from this experience?
- ✓ How will this experience benefit you in your chosen career path?

Your statement should be a well-developed, multi-paragraph response to the questions above.

Please write your statement in this template, save the document as a Word or PDF (16MB maximum in size), and attach it to your online application where prompted.
