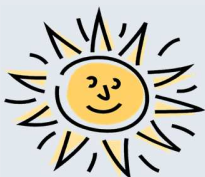

Elementary schools will be closed for summer effective 3:00 p.m. on June 28th. They will reopen during the week of August 26th.

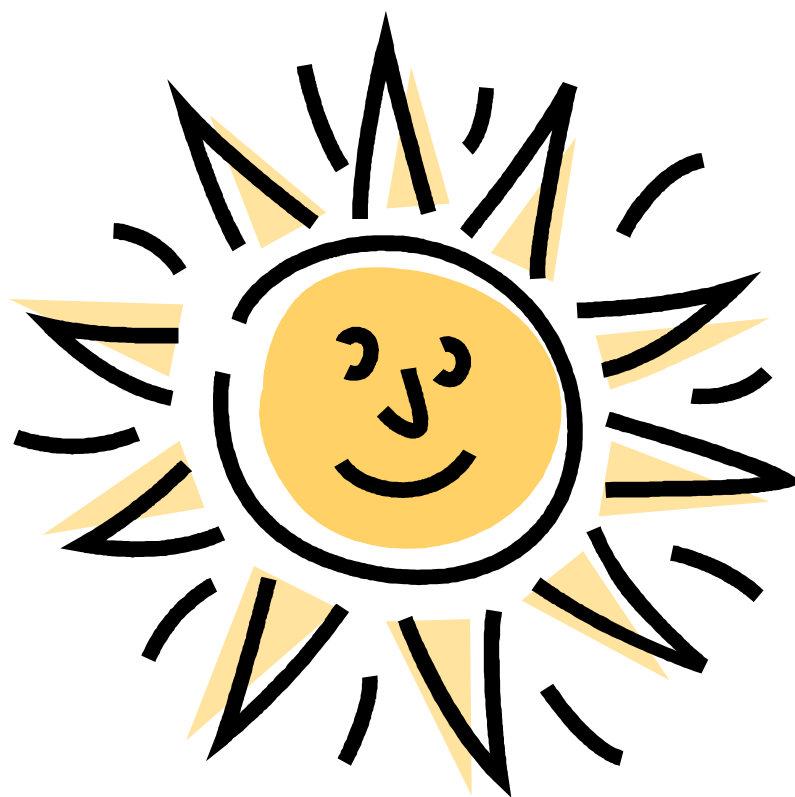
Note: All schools will be closed on July 1st- Canada Day,
