- Applications must have volunteer hours at the Kelly Road Christmas Craft Fair in either or both of their senior year (grade 11 and/or 12)
- After meeting the above requirements, applicants with extra community volunteer hours (e.g. the Senior Citizen Christmas Light Tour at the Hart Community Centre on Sunday) will be considered first.

Selection

The Hart Community Centre Society will select the recipient.

Special Conditions

1. The monetary award will be paid to the place of education at recipient's request.
2. The recipient will have **3 semesters** to enrol. If the recipient is not enrolled in classes by that time, the award is declared "NOT ACCEPTED" and will be returned to the bursary fund for the exclusive use by the Hart Community Centre Society.

- Demonstrated satisfactory academic achievement.

JUDI DUNNETT MEMORIAL BURSARY

Description

This award was established in April, 1993, by family and friends, to honour the memory of Judi Dunnett, an Alternate Education teacher at Kelly Road Secondary for twelve years. She will be remembered for her outstanding work, contributions and empathy for Alternate Education students and for her zest for life in spite of her illness.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have attended Kelly Road Secondary School for at least two years, including graduation year.
- Applicants must have fulfilled graduation requirements after successful completion of the Alternate Education Program at Kelly Road Secondary School.
- Applicants are expected to enrol in a post-secondary training or education program in the fall of the year in which the award is granted. Deferral may be granted for one year upon written request.
- Applicants must show proof of registration in a post-secondary training or education program before the award can be issued.

KELLY ROAD SECONDARY SCHOOL DRY GRAD AWARD

Description

This award was developed by the Kelly Road Dry Grad Committee of 1992 to be granted annually to a graduating student confirming registration to a post-secondary education institution.

Eligibility

- Candidate must participate in Kelly Road Secondary School Dry Grad fundraising activities.
- Candidate must have demonstrated satisfactory academic achievement.
- Candidate must attend a post-secondary education institution.
- Candidate must submit a one-page essay outlining why Dry Grad is important to them and the community as a whole, and what involvement they have had in supporting Dry Grad.
- The recipient of this award may defer the award for up to 15 months.

KELLY ROAD SECONDARY SCHOOL PARENT ADVISORY AWARD

Description

The financial award was established in 1986, to be given annually to Grade 12 students from the Hart Highway area to pursue his/her post-secondary education.

Eligibility

- Candidates must have attended Kelly Road Secondary School for their entire graduating year plus at least one other full year.
- Applicants must have maintained a level of academic achievement consistent with their expressed post-secondary goals.
- The successful candidate(s) must provide proof of registration at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- This award **must be used within 15 months** from date granted.
- Financial need may be taken into consideration.

MARK SWIFT GRADUATION BURSARY

Description

Description

Eligibility

- Applicants must have demonstrated athletic ability in the school and/or community as evidence by letter(s) of reference from their particular coach(es)
- Preference will be given to **one female and one male** graduating student.
- Applicants must register for full-time studies in a recognized post-secondary educational institution.
- Deferment of the award will not exceed one year and any deferment must be agreed to by the administration of the award. Requests for deferment must be outlined in writing.

P.G. MEDICAL STAFF SCHOLARSHIP

Description

- Demonstrated satisfactory academic achievement.
- Applicants must be entering post-secondary education in a medical field which includes: medicine, nursing (including licensed practical nursing), physiotherapy, occupational therapy, lab technology, x-ray technology, dietician, speech therapy and/or another medically allied field.

ROD ECKLAND CNC MEMORIAL BURSARY

Description

This bursary is presented in memory of Rod Eckland who graduated from Kelly Road Secondary School in 1991.

- Candidate must have satisfactory achievement with S's and G's on report card for work habits.
- Candidate should be involved in an organized sport either in or out of school.
- This award **must be used within 15 months** from date granted.
