Bonjour LdB Families,

We hope this letter finds you well. With regular school instruction beginning on Monday, we want to share some important information about our school's enhanced communicable disease safety procedures. These plans have been developed in conjunction with changes to our protocols as outlined by our Provincial Health Officer, Minister of Education, and School District No 57 (Prince George). With these enhanced safety procedures, we continue to do everything possible to ensure our school remains a safe and healthy learning environment for our students.

Before coming to school:

- Please complete a Health Check with your child every day and keep your child home if they are feeling ill
- Please place several properly fitting masks in your child's backpack - they often lose or drop them
- Contact the school if your child will be away
- Visitors are limited to those who support activities that are a direct benefit to student learning and well-being

While at school:

- Students will line up outside by divisions and classes will enter in one division at a time
- Masks are to be worn at all times, including transition outside and when entering the building after recess and lunch.
- Students will wash/sanitize hands as regularly as possible
- Recesses and lunches will be staggered to ensure that only half the students are outside at one time (see new Daily Schedule below)

In the event we are short staffed, we may combine classes. Teachers have prepared for this event to ensure continuity of learning.

In the event that our school has to close due to significant staff absences (functional closure), teachers have developed continuity of learning plans that will be shared with you. This work will focus on practicing essential skills and strategies.

Below, you will find additional information, including our revised Daily Schedule.

We are welcoming all students back to school on Monday, January 10. We are looking forward to having the students back for in-person learning. If you have any question, concerns, comments, please do not hesitate to reach out to us.

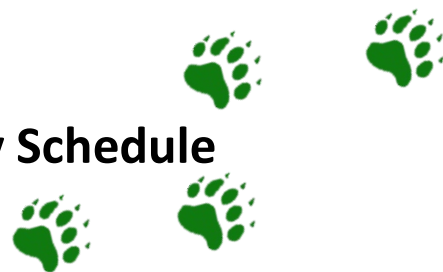

Other Important Safety Protocols

Please Review with your Child(ren)

Masks in School

- All people (excluding those with approved exemption) are required to wear a mask at all times inside the school
- Ensure masks fit properly
- *Please place several masks in your child's backpack. They often lose or drop them*
- Masks may be removed under the following conditions:
 - While eating or drinking
 - While outside
 - During high-intensity physical activity
- If wearing a face shield, a mask must also be worn

Hand Hygiene

- Rigorous hand washing is the most effective way to reduce the spread of illness
- If there is not a sink available, use hand sanitizer. If hands are visibly dirty, soap and water are best
- There are bottles of hand sanitizers available in all rooms for use by both staff and students

Visitors Entering/Exiting the Building

- Visitors are limited to people supporting activities that are of direct benefit to student learning and wellbeing
- Visitors are required to have completed a daily health check (<https://www.sd57.bc.ca/covid/healthchecks/Documents/2021.09.23%20BC%20Daily%20Health%20Check%20for%20students,%20staff%20and%20visitors.pdf>)
- Visitors must sanitize hands before entering
- Visitors are to report to the office to sign-in/sign-out and identify what location they will be in at the school

Developing Symptoms at School

- If a student develops symptoms, staff will contact the office immediately
- The student will be escorted to Room 110 and supervised
- Parents will be contacted from immediate pick up at door #3 (Ospika side near tennis courts)
