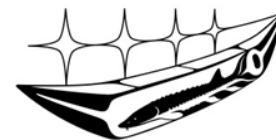




# Eldzi Cho Nun

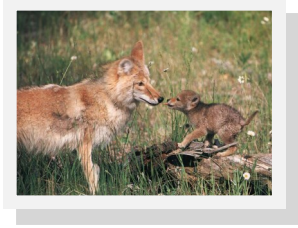

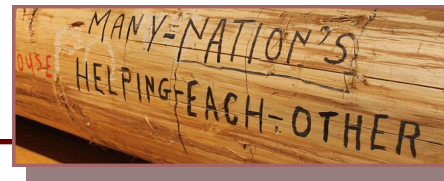
