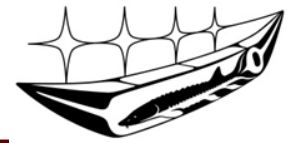

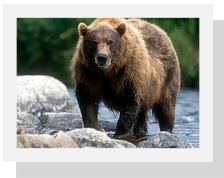

Did you know?

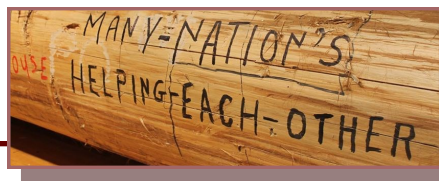
Hadih House offers a variety of free services and programs open to everybody!! Drop-in services include: laundry, computer and internet access, local phone calling and faxing,
