I would like to take this time to first wish you well, and second share some of our school plans. These plans have come into play as we once again navigate through changes in our protocols as outlined by our Provincial Health Officer, Minister of Education, and our Board Office. We will be doing everything possible to ensure our school can remain open, students learning, and continue to keep everyone safe and healthy.

How you can help:

- *Do DAILY HEALTH CHECK with your child
- *Keep your child home if they are feeling sick
- *Drop off your child close to morning start (8:35)
- *Pick up close to dismissal bell (2:27)
- *Contact the school if your child is away
- *No visitors to building except educational personnel

How we can help:

- *Students will line up outside their division doors to enter building – or front door if late
- *Teachers will let students in one division at a time
- *We will reduce any congestion in common areas
- *We will reinforce mask wearing
- *We will reinforce hand hygiene
- *Only one to two classes outside during a recess break (we will run multiple recesses a day)
- *Staggered lunch time between divisions
- *No visitors to building except educational personnel

In the event we are **short staffed**, we have a plan in place to ensure students can still attend. This may include combining classes. Teachers have worked together to develop work for the combined classes.

In the event that our **school has to close to in person learning**, teachers will put together work packages that will be sent home. We will have a pick up and drop off procedure in place for work packages.

As of Monday, January 10, we are open to all our students. Homework packages and online teaching are not being provided as we are not looking at transitional learning at this time. If your child is away, please continue to build skills by reading to, and with them, and doing daily numeracy and literacy work. Our district website has many learning activities that students have access to under the tab, "Learning from Home."

In the meantime, I am looking forward to having the students back on Jan 10th, and moving forward with in-person learning.
