We are into the final two months of the 2021/2022 school year. It is hard to believe that the spring is finally here, and summer break is just around the corner.

We are very excited to again have an in-person graduation ceremony this year and planning is well underway. Our Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony will be held at the Prince George Civic Center on June 3, 2022 at 1 pm. There is also a mandatory rehearsal for our Grade 12 students. Please note, to accommodate our ceremony on June 3, there will be an early dismissal for all students at 11:26 am. This allows for our staff to attend the ceremony and see the students, who they have worked with for five years now, to participate in this day of celebration.
